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
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Report on Online Faculty Development Programme on 'Modalities in using Zoom Platform for Online Teaching'


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


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QUICK CALCULATIONS USING VEDIC MATHEMATICS

Outcome: The participants got a clear understanding of the paper pattern for their respective subjects. Their queries were also resolved by the resource person.





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
REPORT ON WEBINAR ON "UNLOCKING INVESTMENT MANTRA"

Outcome: The participants understood the need for financial planning, the various investment avenues, especially about shares and mutual funds.





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
REPORT ON WEBINAR ON "QUICK CALCULATIONS USING VEDIC MATHEMATICS"
