#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM**


- To make students learn systematic method for acquiring data and studying it for taking conclusion.

**Brief Summary**: The college students got opportunity to introduce themselves to NSDL's educational initiatives being organized for students for making them under their 'Prudent Investor' scheme. NSDL is amongst the largest depositories in the world. Established in 1996, they have state-of-art infrastructure that handles most of the securities held and settled in dematerialized form in Indian securities market. At NSDL, they have more than 89% market share of custody value which is more than US\$ 4 Trillion (or ₹320 Lakh Crore). Investors are offered depository services from 57000+ service centers. NSDL's investors are present in 99.2% of pin codes in India and spread across 189 countries.


