

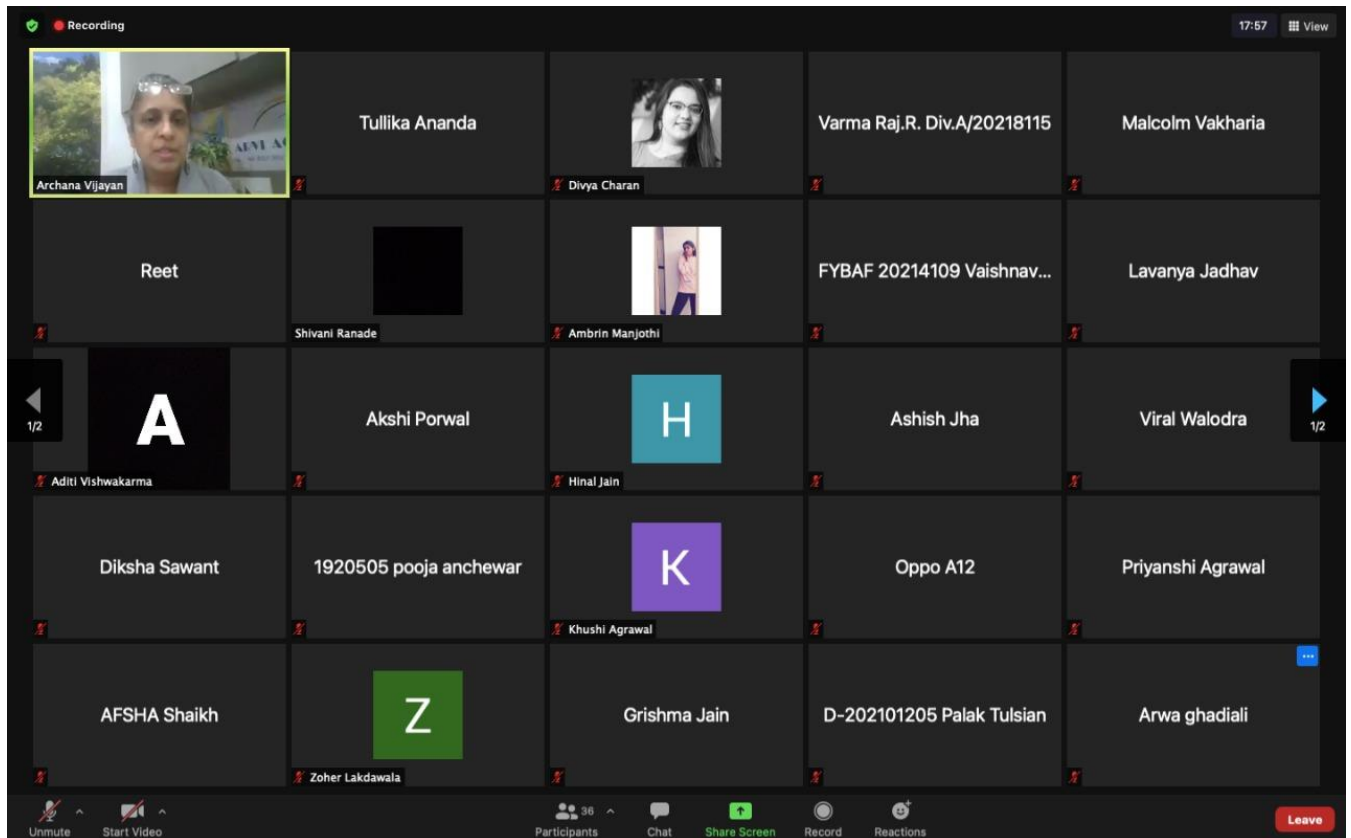

To guide the students on various soft skills required to be employable in this competitive market.


To guide the students on how to prepare for such soft skills.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

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

BRIEF REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY



- They were even informed about the various governmental incentives given to start ups.



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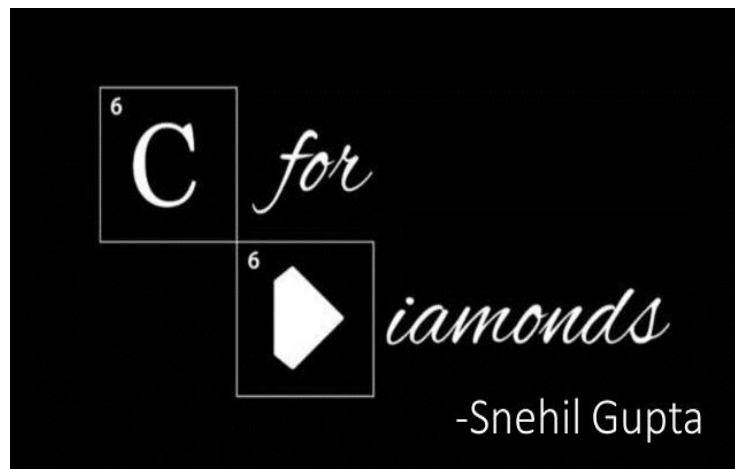



- ✓ How to proceed post establishment of brand.



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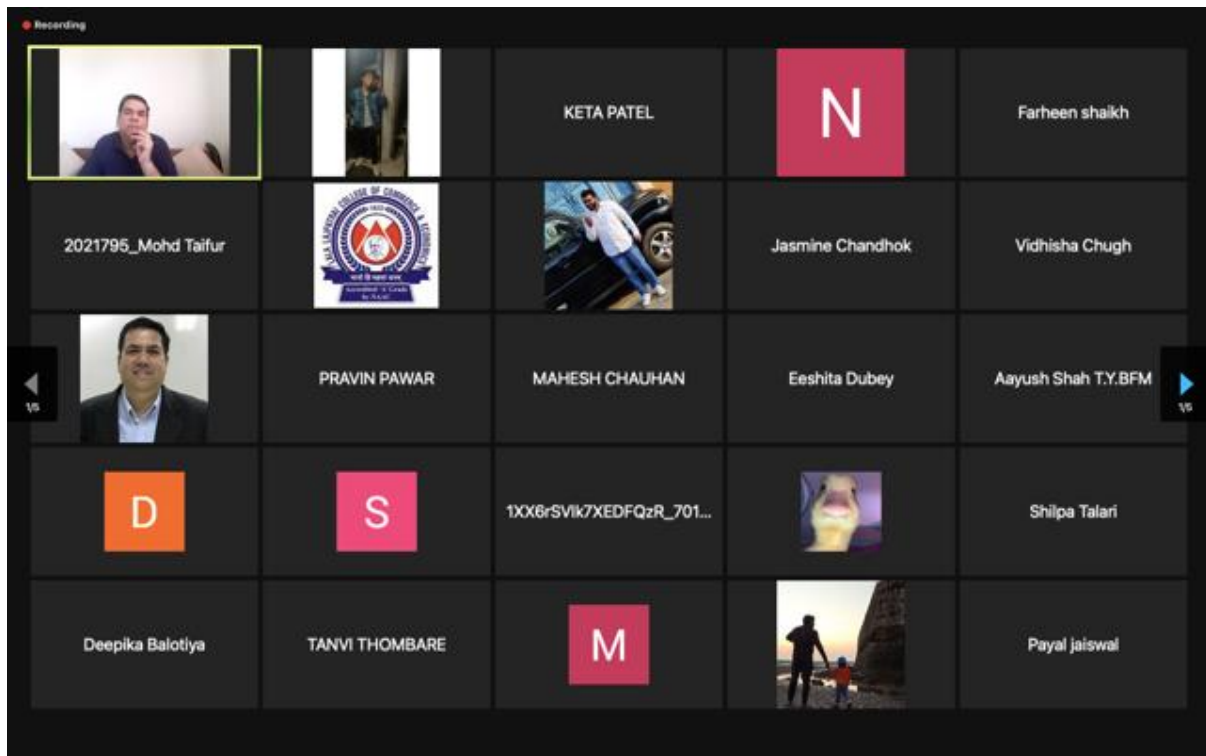


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
A. Y. 2021-22 Orientation organized by SFC

future career prospects they can expect. It was an interactive session and the students had many queries which were fully answered to the satisfaction of the students



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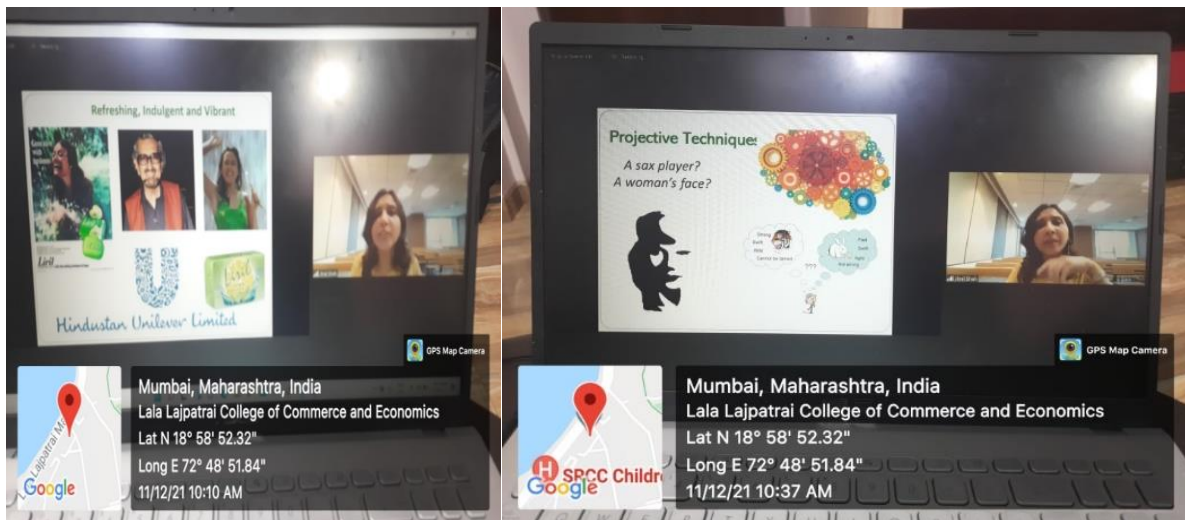

- To clear doubts and develop understanding in students for research work.


BRIEF REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY

BRIEF REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY


