


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FY & SY PPT PRESENTATION COMPETITION

- 2. Sensitization towards scarcity of water and possible future trouble was achieved.

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
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RENEWABLE ENERGY RESOURCES

Outcome


A large number of students participated in the webinar and students got the opportunity to learn about various renewable resources available and thus about Nature Conservation.
