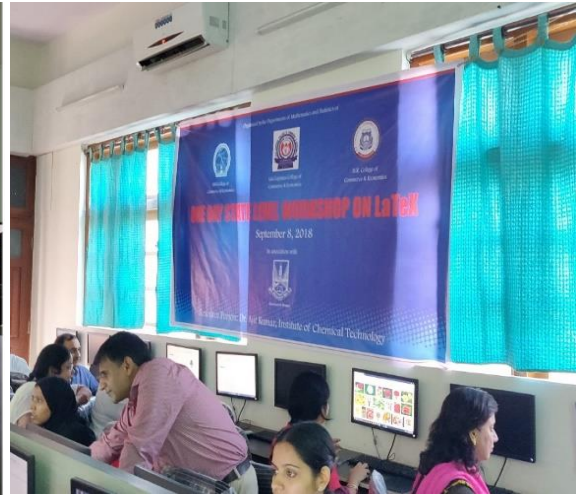


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LaTeX WORKSHOP

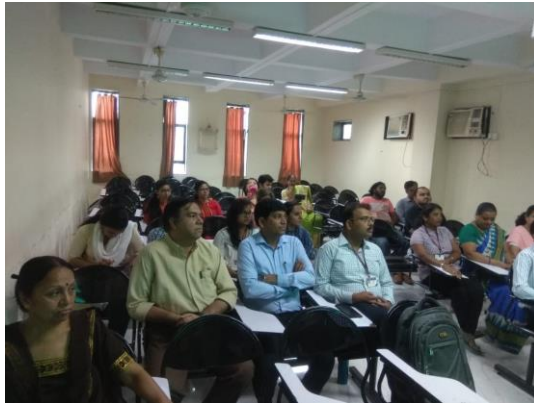


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EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE- THE SKILL HIDING IN PLAIN SIGHT OF LIFE
