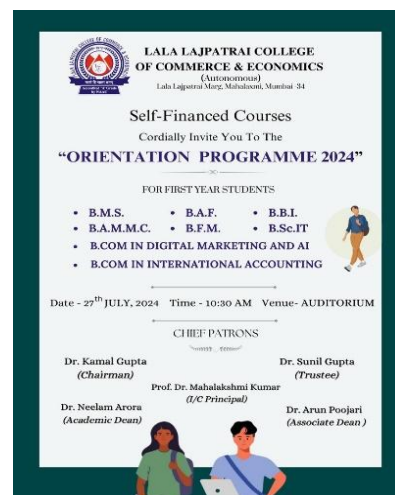


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FY ORIENTATION PROGRAMME 2024

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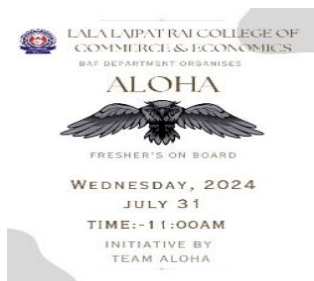


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ALOHA ORIENTATION

- 2)The students have been educated about the how to peruse these careers.

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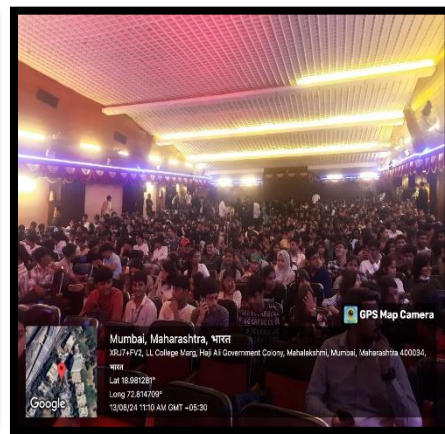


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PRODIGY OPENING PROGRAM

- 2)The students have been educated about the key issues related to the topic .

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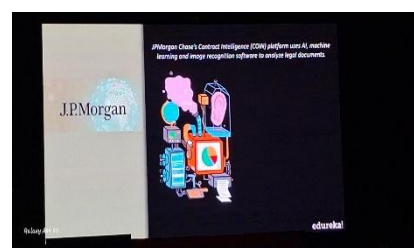
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AI SKILLS FOR FUTURE LEADERS
