1. To create awareness among students about the consequences of ragging and the importance of maintaining a safe and respectful academic environment.



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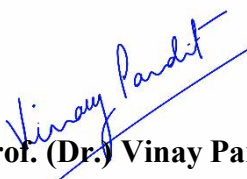
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2. To develop critical thinking and ethical decision-making skills through analysis of real-life case studies related to ragging incidents.
